CONDEMNING THOSE WHO TRIED TO OVERTHROW THE RESULTS OF A FREE AND  
FAIR ELECTION BY VIOLENTLY ATTACKING THE UNITED STATES CAPITOL, OUR  
CONSTITUTION, AND OUR NATION

WHEREAS, the United States Capitol building, which houses the meeting chambers of the House of Representatives and the Senate, stands as a monument to the American people and our open, transparent, and Democratic government; and

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2021, a group of insurrectionists, domestic terrorists, physically attacked the U.S. Capitol in an attempt to prevent a peaceful transfer of power; and,

WHEREAS, these domestic terrorists came armed with pipe bombs, Molotov cocktails, assault rifles, handguns, hundreds of rounds of ammunition, stun guns, handcuffs, and zip ties; and,

WHEREAS, we condemn actions of the coordinators of the insurrection, the armed extremists, including white supremacists and anti-Semites, who led the attack to overthrow American Democracy; and,

WHEREAS, we unequivocally denounce the mob who overran the seat of our Government, who violently overtook the Capitol Police; and,

WHEREAS, we condemn the horrific murder of Capitol Police Officer Brian Sicknick, who was beaten to death by the mob of extremists; and,

WHEREAS, we confirm our commitment to be ever vigilant to protect and defend Democracy because what threatens our Democracy most is not from outside the United States, but from within; and,

WHEREAS, we further confirm our commitment to uphold and defend the Constitution from those who would attempt to undo by force a free and fair election, and we assert that the rights of freedom of speech and assembly do not give anyone the right to resort to violence, sedition, or insurrection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ventura County Board of Supervisors condemns in the strongest possible terms those who tried to overthrow the results of a free and fair election by violently attacking the United States Capitol, our Constitution, and our Nation.

We should condemn the murder of the Capitol Police Officer Brian Sicknick, who was horrifically beaten to death by the mob; that extremists who led the attack to overthrow American democracy included white supremacists and anti-semitics.

The coordinators of the insurrection, the people with zip-tie handcuffs, armed in battle fatigues and with bombs, were domestic terrorists. We must condemn the hate and lies.

The breaching of the Capitol showed the vulnerability of our institutions of government and was another reminder of an unequal nation, when white extremists can easily storm the United States Capitol, but peaceful protestors got tear-gassed in front of the Capitol last summer.

Let the resolution reconfirm our commitment to be ever vigilant, to protect and defend democracy; because what threatens our democracy most is not from outside the United States, it's from within.

Further, we expect all who serve, uphold, and defend the Constitution, just as three members this morning took our oath when they were sworn in today; we expect no less of the President and members of the Senate and the House of Representatives.

the vulnerability of our Institutions of Government and was another reminder of an unequal nation when white extremists can easily storm the United States Capital; comments peaceful protestors were tear gassed in front of the Capital last summer; comments on letting the resolution reconfirm our commitment to be ever vigilant to protect and defend democracy; comments what threatens our democracy most is not from outside of the United States, it's from within; comments further expecting all who served to uphold and defend the Constitution, expecting no less of the President and the members of the Senate and the House of Representatives; comments on condemning those who would attempt to undo by force a free and fair election, and those who deliberately mislead them; comments our oath to uphold the Constitution compels us to act now; comments hoping her fellow Supervisors will join her in voting unanimously when the resolution is brought back to the Board of Supervisors at the next meeting.
